The ISHL has implemented a new incentive program to help High School Hockey Clubs promote and advance ice hockey for high school players. This program is eligible to only those clubs currently participating in the ISHL.

The League is offering a **monetary gift** to High School Hockey Clubs for each approved qualifying event. Clubs are eligible for a maximum gift of \$500 per program fiscal year (April 1 through March 31). Every Club is encouraged to take advantage of this program.

The Club must submit a **separate application for each qualifying event**. Qualifying events must have entire Club participation, not just team. Clubs that have team(s) participating in another league, as well as in the ISHL, qualify for this program.

Substantiating documentation must also be provided. Signatures of the Club's current President and Treasurer are necessary for the application to be considered valid.

We encourage all Clubs to 'think out of the box' when planning an event. Qualifying events could be, but are not limited to:

- ✓ Hosting a Tournament
- ✓ Participating in Parades
- ✓ Community Service
- ✓ Skate With Events
- ✓ Car Washes

Qualifying events and applications must occur within the current program fiscal year (April 1 through March 31).

Incentive payments will be made to the Clubs as submitted. All applications must be submitted with substantiating documents and

signatures, incomplete applications will not be considered.

Incentive applications must be submitted no later than 30 days after program fiscal year end (April 30) to be considered.

Incentive payment amounts are determined by the Incentive Program Committee.
